

Co-op Work Permit Application Guide

Note: Please apply for your co-op work permit at least 4 months before you are scheduled to begin your work term.

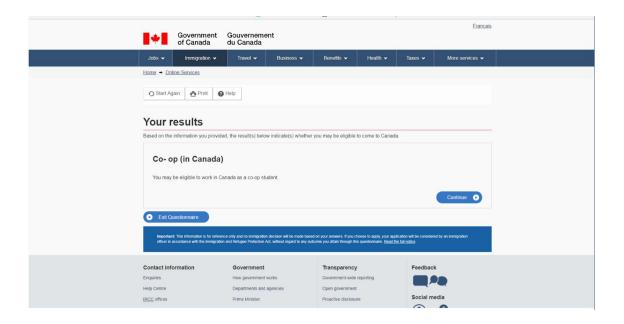
*Processing time can vary, and you cannot start work without a permit.

Please follow the instructions below to apply for your co-op work permit:

1. Log into my CIC through GCKey or Sign-in partner

If you are a new user, you will need to register. Your Client ID from your Study Permit is required to complete the registration. http://www.cic.gc.ca/english/e-services/mycic.asp

- Complete the 'Come to Canada' questionnaire: http://www.cic.gc.ca/ctc-vac/cometocanada.asp
- 3. You should see the screen below. Click "Continue"



4. Click "Continue" on the next screen to get your document checklist. You will need to provide a few more answers.

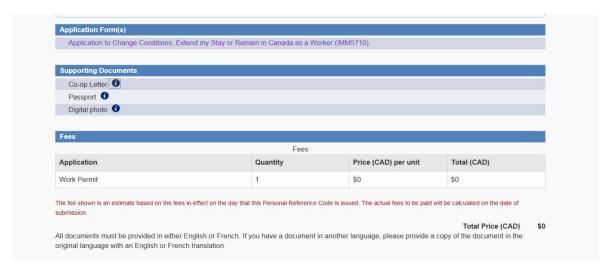
